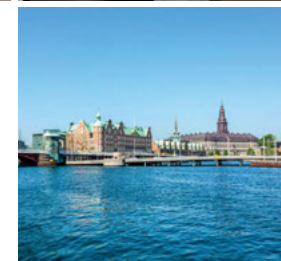


Accommodation ▲
